The invigilating enhancements, issued by the DVSA affecting our ADR courses will impact some of our customers from March 2025 however we aim to minimise these whilst ensuring the integrity of the examination process is adhered to!



FIRST AID AT WORK

INITIAL

This course is aimed at individuals who are new to First Aid or whose certificate has lapsed. It aims to provide the necessary **practical skills** and **confidence** to deal with a **first aid** incident within a **workplace setting**.

These skills are learnt via our hands on approach to training which involves lots of **role play scenarios**, to help keep up with the demands on first aiders.

Our **continual assessment** approach means skills are explained, demonstrated, practiced, and assessed throughout, as the course progresses. Trainees are presented with scenarios detailing some very realistic issues. We feel this type of situation gives the trainees increased confidence in their own skills and abilities, should they ever have to deal with a real-life emergency.

TRANSPORT MANAGEMENT OPERATOR CPC

All applicants for an **Operator's Licence** for **Road Haulage** vehicles must demonstrate **"professional competence"**.

One of the ways to achieve this is by passing the **CILT** Transport Manager Certificate of Professional Competence examinations.

INTENSIVE COURSE



This 10-day (9 days training plus 1 exam day) intensive public course follows the latest exam syllabus, which is based directly on Regulation EC 1071/2009. The course includes an exam preparation day for the two examinations, held at our **approved training centre**. Upon successfully passing the examinations, a certificate will be awarded by CILT (UK).

This qualification is aimed at individuals who want to:

- Enter the profession of Transport Manager, or
- Demonstrate their professional competence to meet Operator Licensing requirements.

Examinations will be conducted **online**, in the comfort of your **own home** / **work environment**. The exam location must however be suitable for examinations, **without distractions**, using a computer with **camera capabilities**.






DANGEROUS GOODS

CARRIAGE OF DANGEROUS GOODS BY ROAD – ADR

This course is for drivers who transport regulated dangerous goods over certain load thresholds by road.



Drivers must attend a **Department for Transport** (DfT) approved course and pass an examination. Once passed, certificates are valid for 5 years.



The course is modular, covering all **9 classes** of dangerous goods including Explosives and Radioactives. Our public course can be tailored so the drivers only need to attend the modules they require.

Attendance on the course can also count for up to a maximum of **28 hours of Driver CPC** training, depending on the modules taken.



Since the introduction of **compulsory computer-based exams in April 2024**, drivers are able to get their results on completion of the full course. This has been hugely successful and beneficial to the driver, especially as the **ADR card is published within 7 days**, for those who have successfully passed.

THE PETROLEUM DRIVER PASSPORT SCHEME - PDP THEORY & PRACTICAL

This course is an **in-work scheme** for drivers working in the Petroleum Industry.





Any driver completing their classroom training needs to be certain they will be able to **complete** their **practical assessment** within **four months**. The passport is **renewed every five years**, but also has an **annual practical assessment** and an **annual classroom training** requirement.

DANGEROUS GOODS SAFETY ADVISER – DGSA

The 5-day DGSA course provides attendees with an **extensive study** of the **National** and **International** Dangerous Goods Regulations.

The training is also a vital grounding for the preparation of an individual to carry out their duties as a 'real world' Dangerous Goods Safety Adviser.

The **Exam Preparation Day** is aimed at those who require **additional exam technique** practice. A valuable session for those who haven't sat formal examinations for some time.

The course prepares the individual to sit the **Scottish Qualification Authority (SQA) examinations**which are held **four** times a year.

CARRIAGE OF DANGEROUS GOODS BY ROAD & SEA

This 3-day course is aimed at candidates who require a **detailed understanding of the ADR & IMDG Regulations** and the ability to use them to validate Dangerous Goods consignments and **problem solve situations** as they arise. Often delivered as an in-company course as the trainer will focus on the consignments relevant to the candidates. Public courses are also available however will focus on the more generic classes of dangerous goods.

It is recommended for candidates to be familiar with Dangerous Goods.

Upon passing the course, candidates will be issued with a CAA approved Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Air certificate, **valid for 2 years**.

LITHIUM BATTERIES BY AIR

As the demand for wireless equipment and electrification increases, so does the demand for the training around the safe transportation of lithium ion & metal cells and batteries by air.

This course is aimed at personnel who are **responsible for arranging movements of regulated lithium batteries / cells** including those involved with classification, packing, labelling and completing / signing off documentation. Upon passing the course candidates will be issued with a CAA approved Carriage of Lithium Batteries by Air certificate, valid for 2 years.

Whilst a large part of the IATA Regulations do not apply, section 1.6 (66th edition) does, which requires 'any person preparing or offering cells or batteries for transport must receive adequate instruction on these requirements commensurate with the functions for which they are responsible'.

This 1-day course is suitable for those personnel who are responsible for the shipment of **Section**II batteries only.

DRIVER CPC

A new year and a new 5-year cycle (for the most) with changes from 3rd December 2024!

As most of you will be aware the government consulted during 2023, on making changes to Driver CPC, to make it more flexible. The outcome from the Consultation is the introduction of a National Driver CPC (NDCPC) from 3rd December 2024.

The new NDCPC will be more flexible as the required 35 hours can be spread over 3.5-hour blocks instead of the current 7-hour courses. The downside to the NDCPC is that if a driver attends any NDCPC they will only be issued an NDCPC card on completion of all 35 hours irrespective of whether they have attended any 7-hour courses!

Attending our 7-hour courses, as shown below, will provide you with hours towards the International Driver CPC (IDCPC) and NDCPC.

> 9 ADR – Carriage of Dangerous Goods - up to 21 hours DG₁ 0 DG₂ **DG 3** 6 ADR – Tanker Familiarisation – 7 hours **DG 4** 9 Emergency First Aid at Work - 7 hours

Our Driver CPC modular courses, consisting of 4 x 3.5-hour modules, suitable for NDCPC and IDCPC will cover a variety of subjects relevant to a driver's role.

A driver can attend 1 x 3.5-hour course a day to gain a NDCPC or they can attend 2 x 3.5-hour modules to gain the IDCPC which can be combined in pairs to make a 7-hour course. The modules we have available for 2025 include:


